Title IX: The Spirit of the Law

Title IX is about equitable access to education and applies to educational institutions. While many of the current concerns and headlines about liability and equitable rights focus on investigation and adjudication of sexual assault between students, which is incredibly important, Title IX encompasses much more in compliance expectations in response to its 37 words: “No person in the United States shall, on the basis of sex, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any education program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance.”

Progress demands that institutions focus not only on responding to reports but how we respond to such reports, with dignity and equity, and more importantly what else is being done to create an environment free from discrimination and harassment. This keynote will provide a broad overview of compliance considerations for Title IX Coordinators in practice, calling for a holistic, inclusive approach that attends to the environmental and structural factors, acknowledges the dynamics of trauma and the complexity of human behavior, as well as training members of the community at all levels, addressing behaviors that may create or perpetuate harmful conditions.
